SADDLE UP AND DISCOVER ANCIENT WORLDS OF POLO

Discover India's exciting emerging northeastern frontier with a unique, riding and polo adventure in Manipur, the birthplace of modern polo. Watch the Team USPA Women play with Manipuri women polo players in a tournament organized by the Tourism Department in association with the All Manipuri Polo Association to celebrate Manipur's Statehood Day. Ride on the rare Manipuri Pony in the mornings. Then luxuriate in Jaipur's world of palaces and pageantry, and polo at the Maharaja Sawai Bhawani Singh Cup.

ITINERARY*

Day 1: Saturday, January 16: Arrival

Fly into Imphal Airport. Transfer to the Hotel. Decompress with live NE rock music at the Polo Lounge. Later have dinner at the hotel.

Day 2: Sunday, January 17: Imphal

Go for a pony ride this morning. Visit the shrine of the god of polo. Tournament Opening Ceremony and game in the afternoon followed by leisure time or live NE rock music. Optional special screening: MANIPURI PONY (Aribam Syam Sharma, 2013, 50 min) is award-winning documentary on Manipur's pony culture. Overnight.

Day 3: Monday, January 18: Imphal

Sightseeing on pony back followed by walking tour of Imphal. In the afternoon or Go shopping in Imphal's famous women's market. Later, local rock music at the Polo Lounge, with optional preview of RIDERS OF THE MIST (Roopa Barua, 2014, 65 min), international award-winning film on bareback pony racing in Assam. Overnight.

Day 4: Tuesday, January 19: Imphal

After pony rides in the morning, take a Manipuri cooking class with a 3-star chef. In the afternoon, watch the US and Manipuri women polo game. Then pack an overnight bag and proceed to Loktak Lake. Dinner at a lakeside restaurant. Overnight on Sendra Island.

Day 5: Wednesday, January 20: Loktak Lake

Drive to Loktak Lake, the largest lake in the North East. Explore the colourful lakeside fishing villages by boat. Return to Imphal after lunch at Sendra Island resort in time for the afternoon polo game. Overnight in Imphal.

Day 6: Thursday, January 21: Imphal

Lunch today is at an extravagant ritual feast at the Palace Temple with a traditional choir of Sankirtan music. In the afternoon attend the colourful closing ceremony of the tournament and enjoy the final match. Overnight.

Day 7: Friday, January 22: Jaipur

This morning after breakfast, checkout and leave Imphal by flight. Arrive Delhi in time and transfer to the flight to Jaipur. Dinner at Raj Palace, a royal heritage hotel. Overnight.

Day 8: Saturday, January 23: Jaipur

Sightseeing at City Palace and Jantar Mantar. Regional cuisine lunch at a local restaurant. Back to the hotel. Overnight.

Day 9: Sunday, January 24: Jaipur

Early morning visit Amber Fort and take an elephant ride. Later, return for lunch and polo at the Maharaja Sawai Bhawani Singh Cup. Overnight.

Day 10: Sunday, January 25: Departure

Post breakfast, leave for visit to the local market for shopping. Jaipur is famous for its ethnic clothing and jewelry. Lunch at hotel. Check out. Fly to New Delhi. Catch connecting international flight or stay on in New Delhi (optional; please contact us).
